PRIVACY NOTICE

This privacy notice applies to Dave Munday Photography (Stanwick Photos) and the photography website at www.stanwickphotos.uk and www.stanwickphotos.org.uk.

How we use your information

This privacy notice tells you what to expect when we collect personal information. We will make it clear when we collect personal information and will explain what we intend to do with it. We do not share your personal information with third parties unless we have your consent or to comply with a legal obligation.

Those seeking to purchase or use photographs or other content

We will obtain information from enquirers seeking to purchase or use photographs or other website content sufficient to process their enquiry or to maintain contact. In addition, if the requested photographs or other content include children or vulnerable adults, we may seek additional information to confirm that the enquirer is entitled to receive the photographs or other content.

Visitors to the website

When someone visits the photography website at www.stanwickphotos.org.uk, we collect standard internet log information and details of visitor behaviour patterns. We do this to find out things such as the number of visitors to the various parts of the site. We collect this information in a way that does not identify anyone and we do not attempt to find out the identities of those visiting this website. We will not associate data gathered in this way with any personally identifying information from any source.

Cookies

Cookies are small text files that are placed on your computer by websites that you visit. They are widely used in order to make websites work, or work more efficiently, as well as to provide information to the owners of the site.

Use of cookies by the web host provider (Moonfruit)

Moonfruit is a company that provides users with the ability to build their own websites. The SiteMaker software that they use places cookies to:

Persist the login of a user during a session at a given site.

Automatically log a user in, if they have previously click "Remember me" when logging in.

These cookies are essential in order to enable you to move around the website and use its features, such as accessing secure areas of the website. Without these cookies services you have asked for, like shopping baskets or e-billing, cannot be provided.

Use of cookies by the Dave Munday Photography (Stanwick Photos) website

These cookies collect information about how visitors use a website, for instance which pages visitors go to most often, and if they get error messages from web pages. These cookies do not collect information that identifies a visitor. All information these cookies collect is aggregated and therefore anonymous. It is only used to improve how a website works.
